**Position:** EHS Manager

This position has one direct report, reports to the Plant Manager and will lead various eh&s teams at the plant. The focus for this position is safety and approximately 70-80% of this person's time will be devoted to it.

**Qualifications:** A minimum of 10 years experience in high-risk industry such as chemical plants and pipelines or equivalent with demonstrated knowledge of environmental legislation and regulations implementation pertaining to "air" including Title V and MACT.
